

MARKING AND HANDLING OF LITHIUM ION BATTERIES UN3480, Section II, ACCORDING TO IATA 59th EDITION.

Ref. packing instruction 965, section II

PACKING:

- Cells and batteries must be packed in strong outer packagings that conform to 5.0.2.4, 5.0.2.6.1 and 5.0.2.12.1
- Cells and batteries must be packed in inner packagings that completely enclose the cell or battery.
- Max. 2 batteries per box.
- Only 1 package is allowed per consignment and only by Cargo Aircraft.
- The state of charge (SoC) per battery must not exceed 30% capacity.
- All boxes must be labelled with a lithium battery handling label (Figure 7.4.H) (on the label must be written: Lithium Ion Battery and phone number)
 The box must also be labelled with a Cargo Aircraft Only label (Figure 7.4.B)



DOCUMENTATION:

AWB or document to follow the goods must contain the following information:

- The package contains lithium ion batteries
- Package must be handled with care
- Flammability hazard exists if the package is damaged
- If the package is damaged the package should be inspected and repacked if necessary.
- Additional information: ph: +45 39 55 88 00

The words "Lithium ion batteries in compliance with Section II of PI 965" and the word "CAO" must be Included on the AWB
