

MARKING AND LABELLING OF DANGEROUS GOODS –
LITHIUM METAL BATTERIES PACKED WITH EQUIPMENT– UN3091 -CLASS 9, ACCORDING
TO IATA 59th EDITION.

Ref. packing instruction 969, section I

Dangerous goods shipments have to be packed in boxes which are UN approved for packing group II. The following markings/labels are required:

- Shipper's full name and address
- Consignee's full name and address
- Proper shipping name: UN3091 Lithium Metal Batteries packed with equipment
- Dangerous goods label: Class 9 – Miscellaneous dangerous goods
- By transport on passenger aircraft the batteries must be packed in either a rigid metal intermediate or a metal outer packaging
- Max. 5 kg net per box by passenger aircraft – max. 35 kg net per box by cargo aircraft
