REACH & RoHs DECLARATION

EU Directive for Registration, Evaluation, Authorization of Chemical substances REACH (1907/ 2006/ EC)

Since Netwave Systems BV neither produces chemical materials or substances itself nor imports them into the EU, REACH classifies Netwave Systems BV as a so-called 'downstream user'. This means that the registration obligations from the REACH regulation are not directly applicable to Netwave Systems BV as a manufacturer of Netwave, McMurdo and Kannad Marine branded maritime products. Nevertheless, we have informed all our suppliers about REACH and instructed them to comply with all their obligations, including registration fees, arising from the REACH directive.

EU regulation for Restriction of Hazardous substances RoHs (2011/ 65/ EU)

The RoHS Directive defines the restriction of certain hazardous substances in electrical and electronic equipment. The directive currently specifies maximum concentrations for the following hazardous substances.

| Bis(2-Ethylhexyl) phthalate (DEHP): | < 0.10% |
| Benzyl butyl phthalate (BBP): | < 0.10% |
| Dibutyl phthalate (DBP): | < 0.10% |
| Diisobutyl phthalate (DIBP): | < 0.10% |

Netwave Systems BV declares that all our Netwave, McMurdo and Kannad Marine branded products are manufactured in accordance with RoHS. We have taken additional steps towards our suppliers regarding RoHS, and have instructed them to fulfil their obligations towards RoHS.
